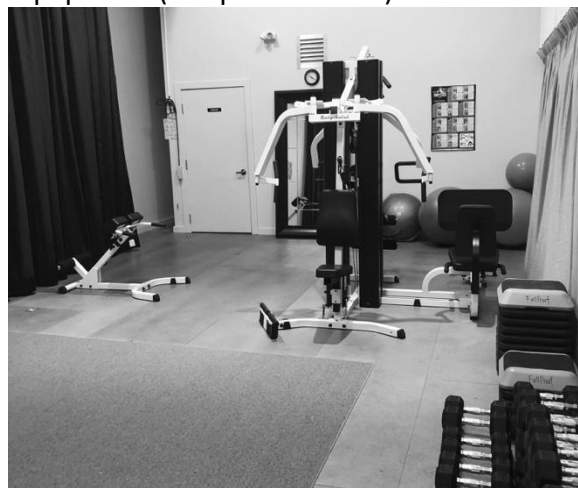

Purchasing a Membership

The Saturna Recreation & Cultural Centre Society relies on revenue generated from operations and donations. Major sources of income continue to be special functions, facility rentals and the continuing support of local organizations. Government funding comes in the form of grants from Saturna Parks and Recreation and/ or the Capital Regional District. Membership fees are a small percentage of revenue.

By purchasing a membership, you will be provided with the access code to the Recreation Centre doors. You will then have access to the building for all activities from 7:00 a.m. to 1:00 a.m. Activities include pickleball, badminton, fitness classes, bridge, a dedicated cardio equipment room and a stretch and strength area with weights and weight training equipment (see photo below).
